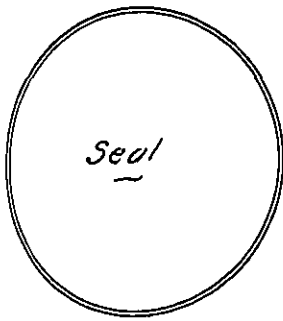

At the Request of Isaac Woods of the County of Philadelphia That we would grant him a Resurvey on a certain Tract of Land on part whereof he is seated adjoining to the Mann^r of Moreland in the County aforesaid reputed to contain three hundred and eighty acres, purchased by the s^d Isaac of ffrancis Searle and is made up of one Tract of 200 acres purchased by ye s^d ffrancis & Company of Joseph ffisher Exec^r to Thomas Terwood and of 180 acres parcel of 500 acres purchased by ye s^d ffrancis &c. of Silas Crispin Exec^r to Thomas Holme: These are to Authorize and require you or either of you exactly to resurvey the s^d Tract of Land according to the true Metes and Bounds by which they were originally Survey'd & laid out & by which they were purchased by the s^d Isaac, and make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by ye Secretary.
