



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Commissioners to me directed bearing date the 19<sup>th</sup> of the 3<sup>d</sup> month 1702 to Resurvey unto Joseph Wood a Tract of Land situate in falls township in the County of Bucks on which he is seated, Together with an Island called Woods Island adjoining, formerly Surveyed for 478 acres upon old Rent, Resurveyed unto the said Joseph Wood the said Tract Beginning at a stone by the River Delaware at the Corner of a tract of land formerly belonging to Daniel Brinsley, now to the s<sup>d</sup> Joseph Wood, and George Biles, Thence by the s<sup>d</sup> Land W.S.W. 201 perches to a stone, Then by the same W. by N. 3 deg<sup>s</sup> N. 219 per. to a stone for a corner, Then by Jeffrey Hawkins land N. 15 deg<sup>s</sup> W. 4 1/2 per. to a black oak, Then N.W. 46 per. to a Maple at Hawkins Corner, Then N. 40 deg<sup>s</sup> W. by John Luff's Land 32 p. to a great white oak marked for a Corner, Then by the same Land N. 15 deg<sup>s</sup> E. 59 p. to a stone, Then N.E. by E. 318 perches to a stone by the said River on the N.W. side of a Small Creek's mouth called Potato Creek, Then down the said River S. 40 deg<sup>s</sup> E. 52 p.; Then S. 45 deg<sup>s</sup> E. 52 p.; Then S. 43 deg<sup>s</sup> E. 36 p.; Then S. 32 deg<sup>s</sup> E. 14 p.; Then S. 10 deg<sup>s</sup> E. 27 p.; Then S. 25 deg<sup>s</sup> W. 21 p.; Then S. 15 deg<sup>s</sup> E. 80 p. The Island begins at the upper Corner, Thence down the back side S.E. 20 p.; Then S.E. by S. 20 p.; Then S. 29 deg<sup>s</sup> E. 40 p.; Then S. 17 deg<sup>s</sup> E. 88 p.; Then S. 8 deg<sup>s</sup> E. 20 p.; Then S. 82 deg<sup>s</sup> W. 2 p.; Then up the other side N. 42 deg<sup>s</sup> W. 48 p.; Then N. 38 deg<sup>s</sup> W. 40 p.; Then N. 15 deg<sup>s</sup> W. 72 per.; Then N. 25 deg<sup>s</sup> E. 28 p.; Then N. 33 deg<sup>s</sup> W. 10 p.; Then East 2 p. to the beginning Containing 3 1/2 Acres, Resurveyed the 4<sup>th</sup> of the 6<sup>th</sup> month 1702
