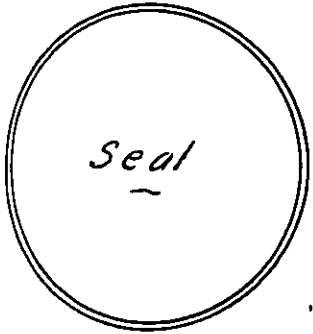

At the Request of Isabel Cutler That I would grant her a Resurvey on a Certain Tract of Land on w^{ch} she is seated, situate in the County of Bucks adjoining on the Line of Joseph Growdon on the one hand and Rob^t Marsh on the other Laid out for 200 Acres to Jⁿ Gilbert on Rent by him Sold to Hugh Marsh and by him to Edmond Cutler the s^d Isabel's late husband. These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey or cause to be resurvey'd the said Tract of 200 Acres according to its first Bounds and Lines of Survey And make Returns thereof into my Secretaries Office.
