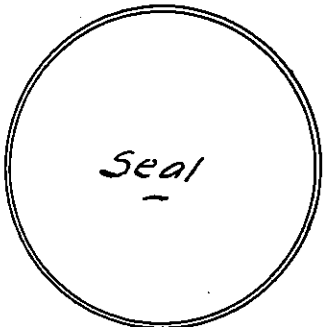

At the Request of Samuel Carpenter That we would grant him a Resurvey on a certain Tract of Land Scituate between the Counties of Bucks and Philadelphia adjoining on the Lands of Joseph Fisher Charles Jones &c laid out for four thousand four hundred and twenty Acres. These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey to the said Samuel Carpenter the said Tract of Land according to its first Bounds and true lines of survey and make Returns thereof into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delivered to thee certified by ye Secretary who is to take a Duplicate of thy Return into his Office. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 6th day of the ^{Second} ~~first~~ Month 1702
