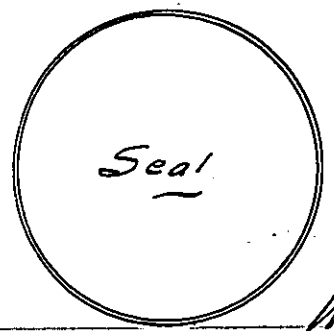

Whereas in the Execution of a Warrant Granted by the Proprietor bearing date the 17<sup>th</sup> day of the thid Mo<sup>th</sup> 1700 for laying out unto William Cowper five Hundred Acres of Land in right of Christopher Atkinson Purchaser of one thousand Acres, Complaint hath been made to us that an Error hath been committed and that there is a Deficiency of a considerable Number of Acres therein, for w<sup>ch</sup> the heirs of the said William have besought us that we would make them Reparation. Now for the more effectual Discovery of ye said Error if any be, These are to Authorise & Require thee to Resurvey or cause to be Resurveyd exactly & according to the first Outlines thereof, the said Tract as laid out for five hundred Acres as afores<sup>d</sup>. And make Returns thereof into the Secretaries Office. Given under our hands & seal of the Province at Philad<sup>ia</sup> the 13<sup>th</sup> of the 6<sup>th</sup> Mo<sup>th</sup> 1712
