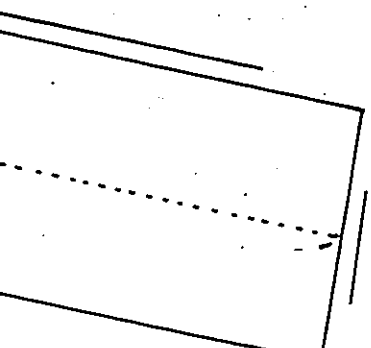

 Pemberton directed bearing date the 21st of the 11th month 1701 and by virtue
 of a warrant from the Commissioners to John Cutler bearing date the 10th day
 of the 1st month - Authorizing him to execute all warrants directed to
 the Phineas Pemberton He the said John Cutler hath made Returns into the
 Gen^l Surv^rs office of the Resurvey of a parcel of land Resurvey'd to George
 Claypool the 21st of the first month 1702 which being examined and revised
 in the said office is as followeth - viz^t

Scituate in Bensalem Township in the County of Bucks Beginning at a black
 oak saplin at Nehemiah Allen's Corner by Delaware River from thence extend-
 ing North North West by the said Allen's land four hundred twenty five perches
 to a post by a black oak thence East north east fifty four perches to a post
 from thence South South east by William Durn's line four hundred thirty seven
 perches to a white oak by the said River Delaware Lastly down the said
 River West by South fifty five perches to the place of beginning Containing
 One hundred forty five acres
