



By virtue of A Warrt frd^o the Proprietaries Commiss^{rs} to me directed bearing d^o the 10th day of the 1st month 17^(^o1) Surveyed and Laid out unto Thomas Carus A Tract of Land in Soulberry Township in Bucks County begining at a Post by a black oak being A Corner of Sedidiah Allen's Land, Thence by the said Allen's Line N.E. 320 perches to a Post near a spanish oak on one side and a white oak on the other side marked TC, Then by vacant Land N.W. 225 per. to a Post by a great maple in a Run, Then by Blackshaw's Line S.W. 320 per. to a Post by a Road, Then by the said Road S.E. 225 per. to the place of beginning Containing 450 acres Surveyed and laid out the 29th day of the 3^d month 1702
