



By virtue of a warrant from the Proprietaries dated the 7th day of July in the year 1733 and By virtue of an order from Jacob Taylor Surveyor Genrol to me directed Surveyed This Tract of Land to Thomas Jenks. This tract of Land Beginning at a white oak standing in Wrights Town Line being the corner of John Johnsons Land then Running Northwest one hundred and nintey two pearches to a marked hickry by the Land lat. Richard Morris then by the Said Morris Land North East one hundred and sixty pearches to a black oak marked being the cornor of Lacey's Land then by the Said Lacy's Land South East one hundred ninty two pearches to a post by a marked black oak then South west one hundred and Sixty pearches along Wrights Town Line by the Land of Garret vansands to the place of beginning. Containing one hundred ninty and two acres Lying in the Township of Buckingham in Bucks County Surveyed August the 14th. in the year 1733.
