By virtue of a Warrant from the Commiss^{rs} of Property bearing date the 5 of the 11th month 1702 for Resurveying Land in the County of Bucks. Resurvey'd unto Daniel Jackson a Certain Tract of Land situate in Mid^{tl}e Township in the County of Bucks. beginning at a black oak standing at a corner of William Paxson's Land. Thence by the said William Paxson's Land South by East one hundred and forty four perches to a black oak again by the said Paxson's Land West by South fifty Nine perches to a post Thence South fifty five degrees West by Jeremiah Langhornes Land twenty two perches to a Spanish oak Thence South East by South by the Land's of Henry Paulin, Henry Paxson and Robert Carter two hundred and eighty four perches to a post. Thence North East by East by George White's Land twenty one perches to a white oak Thence South East by East by the said George Whites Land thirty two perches to a Red oak Then North twelve degrees East sixteen perches to a post. Thence East eighteen Perches to a post Thence North five degrees West one hundred and eighty two perches two perches to a black oak Thence North one degree East one hundred and six perches to a black oak Thence East thirty six perches to a black oak. Thence North two degrees West fifty two perches to a small hickery tree. Then East fifteen perches to a heap of stones. Thence North two degrees West fifty five perches and half to a black oak Thence West by William Paxson's Land two hundred and nine perches to a post Thence South by East sixteen perches to a post. Thence West by North fourteen perches to the place of beginning containing three hundred and Ninety two acres.
