



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Com^{rs} to me directed bearing date the 5th of the 11th month 1702. To resurvey All such Tracts of Land within the County of Bucks as may be reasonably suspected to have been unduly surveyed when first taken up. and have not yet been rectified, Resurveyed unto Griffith Jones a Tract of Land in the sd. County being one moiety of a Tract laid out to Anthony Tomkins for 1000 acres, The said Moiety Beginning at a Post by a black dead tree at the Corner of Robert Turner's land, Then by the sd. Turner's line E. 4 degrees S. 456. perches to a Post, Then by the other moiety of the sd. Tract S. by W. 199 per to a Post by a white oake, Then by Edward Penington's land W. 5 degrs. N. 456 per. to a white oake, Then by Thomas Atkinson's land N. by E. 191 per. to the beginning Containing 550 acres. Resurveyed the 16th day of the 2^d month. 1703.
