



By order from James Logan Surveyed & Laid out unto John ffrost a piece of Land in Newtown in Bucks County. Begining at a Post & heap of Stones in Thomas Hilborn's Line. ffrom thence runing by the sd. John ffrost's Land South by West fifty two perches to a Post. Then by vacant Land North sixty three degrees West twenty two perches & a half to a post by a road. Then by by the sd Road North Sixteen degrees East forty Six perches to a Post in the sd. Thomas Hilborn's Line. Then by the sd. Line East by South Eighteen perches to the place of begining Containing Six acres & twenty perches Laid out the fifteenth day of April, 1713. By me John Cutler.
