



By virtue of three several Warrants from Jacob Taylor Surveyr. Genrl. to me directed, Pursuant to three Warrants from the Commissrs of Property, one bearing date the 30th. of the 5th. month 1712 To Survey unto James Logan 2000 acres in right of Edward Bettris of Oxford Chyrurgeon. Another dated the 17th. of 8^{ber}. Anno Domi. 1713. To Survey unto Jeremiah Langhorn 150 acres in right of ISAAC DEGOW. The third warrant bearing date the 13th. of the 6th. month 1714. To Survey unto Jeremiah Langhorn 500 acres in right of John Rowland & Priscilla his wife & Thomas Rowland. Surveyed & laid out unto the sd. Jeremiah Langhorn a tract of Land in Hilton township in Bucks County. Beginning at a Post in Cott Mildmay's Line, standing between a black oak & a white oak both marked being also Edward Kemp's Corner, ffrom thence runing North West by the sd. Kemp's Line three hundred & twenty perches to a Hickory tree. Then by John Penn's Manor North East five hundred & fourteen perches to a heap of Stones. Then South East by vacant Land three hundred & twenty perches to a Post between a Hickory & a white oak. Then South West by the sd. Mildmay's Line five hundred & fourteen perches to the place of beginning
