

By virtue of a Warrant from the Commiss^{rs}. of Property bearing date the 14th. of the 7th. month 1703 for Resurveying unto Jasper Lawrence Son and Heire of William Lawrence deceased a certain tract of Land Laid out for 450 Acres in Warminster - in the County of Bucks.

Resurvey'd the said tract beginning at a black oak sapling at John Hart's Corner Thence North West by the said John Hart George Randel Joseph Tod Proprietaries Land and Jo Jones one thousand and eighty four perches to a Gum tree, Thence by ^{VACANT LAND} ~~by the Lands of~~ _{by the Lands of} North East sixty eight perches to a post, Then South East by _{Benjamin ffurley James Boyden Valentine Huddleston, David Lloyd, George Willard and John Burden one thousand and eighty four,} ^{perches} to a black oak Then by the Proprietaries land. South West sixty eight perches to the place of beginning. Containing four hundred and sixty eight Acres and an halfe and thirty two peches. Resurvey'd the 18th. of the 5th month 1704 by John Cutler
