

Pursuant to a warrant under the hands of the Commissioners of Property and the seal of the Province bearing date the 21<sup>st</sup>. day of the 11<sup>th</sup>. month, 1701.

There is Resurvey'd unto Joseph Growdon a Tract of land laid out unto Jno. Bowen, Situate in the Township of Bensalem in the County of Bucks beginning at a ditch by the River Delaware from thence by Jonas Skeens land North thirteen degrees west three hundred thirty eight perches to a white oak then east eighteen degrees Northerly by ffairman's land one hundred and sixty perches to a white oak by a Rock at Neshaminy Creek Then down the several courses of the said Creek the several distances on the said courses added together three hundred ninety seven perches to Delaware River then down the same on several Courses one hundred and five perches to the place of beginning. Containing two hundred seventy three acres. Resurvey'd by Jno. Cutler the 29<sup>th</sup>. of the 1<sup>st</sup>. month 170<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>.
