By the Commissioners of Property.
 At the Request of Robert Gerrald of Philadelphia
 that we would Grant him to take up two hundred Acres
 of Land in the Tract called the Great Swamp in Bucks
 County for which he agrees to pay to the Proprietors use Six &
 twenty pounds thirteen Shilling and four pence for the whole
 and the yearly quitrent of one Shilling Sterling for Each hund-
 red Acres. These are to Authorize & Require thee to Survey or
 cause to be Survey'd unto the Said Robert Gerrald in the place
 aforesaid according to the Method of Townships appointed
 the Said quantity of two hundred Acres of Land that has not
 been already Survey'd nor appropriated nor is Seated by the
 Indians and make a Return thereof into the Secretary's Office
 which Survey in case the Said Robert fulfill the above agree-
 ment at ye Location Shall be valid otherwise the same is to
 be void as if it had never been made nor this Warrant ever
 granted. Given under our hands and Seal of the Province
 at Philadd ye 5th of ye 1st month A.D. 1715/6
 To Jacob Taylor Surveyor Gen^l.
