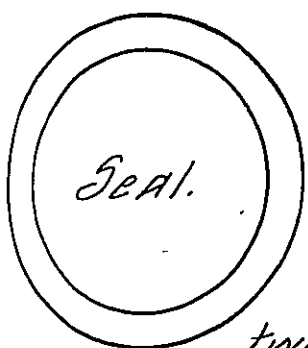


PENNSYLVANIA

Surveyor's Office at Philad^a. where this Warrt. is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by the Secretary.
