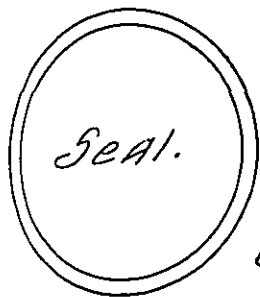

These are to Authorize and require thee forthwith to Survey and lay out to MARY ye Widow of the sd James Heyworth all that Tract of vacant Land Scituate in Newtown in the sd. County or adjacent thereunto between ye Lands of Benjamin Roberts and Jonathan Eldridge for which Land It is agreed that she the sd Mary shall pay or cause to be pd. to the sd. Propry. twenty pounds for every hundred Acres & so proportionably, And make Returns into ye General Surveyor's Office at Philadia. where this Warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be dlvd. to thee certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands & ye Seal of ye Province at Philadia 26th 8^{br} 1702.
