At ye Request of Richard Hugh Purchaser of One Thousand
Acres, yt I would grant him to take up for himself & Thomas
Janey five hundred Acres, between John Crook & Luke Brun-
ley in ye County of Bucks. These are to will & require thee
forthwith. to Survey or cause to be survey'd yt Tract of Land
reserved five hundred Acres on ye waterside in ye most
convenient place & ye remainder divide between ye two
provided it be not already taken up, according to ye method
of Townships appointed by me, & make returns thereof into
my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 12th Octobr.
1683.
