At ye request of James Harrison, ^{purchaser} yt. I would grant him
to take up Three hundred Acres of Land next Sepasting two hund-
red for himself & one hundred for Phinehas Pemberton, lying
in ye County of Bucks. These are to will & require thee forthwith
to survey or cause to be surveyd unto him ye sd. Number of Acres
in ye aforementioned County & Place, where not already taken
up, according to ye method of Townships appointed by me & make
returns thereof into my Secretarys Office. Given at Philadelphia
ye 17th. ^{11th}/_{mo} 1683.
