



By virtue of a warrant from Edward Pennington dated the 18th of the 1st month 1709. ~~By~~ directed to me by James Logan. Pursuant to a warrant from the Proprietary dated the 14th of the 11th month 1700 to lay out unto Robert Heath in Right of Thomas Woolrich 500 Acres of land in the County of Bucks. Surveyed unto the sd. Robert Heath a tract of Land in Souberry township in the sd. County Beginning at a Post by the River Delaware. Thence by the sd. Heath's other land West four hundred seventy five perches to a Post. Then by great spring tract and James Logan North West two hundred and ten perches to a Post and a Stone. Then by Tobias Dymock & vacant land East six hundred and six perches to a black oak by the sd. River. Then down the several courses thereof to the place of beginning Containeing 500 Acres. Laid out the 27th day of the 12th month 1701. By me John Cutler.
