*Two hundred Acres in ye County of Bucks of Sepassy Land. These*  
*are to will & require thee forthwith. to survey or cause to be surv-*  
*eyd unto him ye said Number of Acres according to front in breath*  
*of ye Proportion of Sepassy Land, so it exceed not ye fifteenth*  
*of ye same, where not taken up according to ye Method of Town-*  
*ships appointed by me, & make returns thereof into my Secretary's*  
*Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 29<sup>th</sup>. of ye 12<sup>th</sup> mo. 1683.*
