*By vertue of a warrant from ye Proprietary & Governor Bearing date ye 12th. of ye 5th. mo. 1684. directed to the Surveyr Generall I do by Authority ffrom him Certifie in to ye Secretaries office that there was Surveyed and Laid out ye 26th. of ye said 5th. month 1684 unto Job Howell Two hundred acres of Land [on rent] in ye County of Bucks. Begining at a Cornr. post of William Buckmans Land thence by ye same north East ffour hundred & Sixty perches thence north And by East by a line of trees Twenty ffour perches thence north west ffifty perches, thence South west by Arther Cookes Land ffour hundred and Eighty perches thence South east Sixty seven perches to the place of begining And is Accordingly entred and Recorded in ye Surveyr Generalls office at Philadelphia ye 30th. of ye 8th. moneth 1688.*
