hundred Acres of Land. yt we would grant him to take up Two  
hundred and forty Acres of Land in ye County of Bucks. These  
are to will & require thee in ye Proprietary's Name forthwith to sur-  
vey or cause to be surveyd unto him ye sd. Number of Acres in ye  
aforementioned County adjoining to ye Land assigned to him in  
a Warrant from ye Proprietary where not already taken up.  
According to ye method of Townships Appointed by him he seating  
each Place with a distinct family within six Months from ye Date  
of Survey & make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office  
Given at Philadelphia ye 24th 7br 1684.


