At ye Request of John King yt I would grant him to take up a Lott in ye City. These are to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him a Lott in ye second Street on Delaware fifty foot front, & in length as other Lotts of ye said street run. And make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 21st of ye 10th mo. 1684. 21st
