



By virtue of a warrant from the Commissrs. of Property bearing date the \_\_\_\_\_ Surveyed & laid out unto Morris Morris a Tract of Land in the great Swamp in Bucks County, beginning at a Hickory tree in Joseph Growdon's Line about 32 perches from the north corner, From thence running South by the sd. Line 202 perches to a white Oak. Then west, 420 perches to a white Oak, Then North 202 perches. to a white Oak, Then East 420 perches [all by vacant Land] to the place of beginning Containing five hundred & thirty acres & forty perches, laid out the 29th. day of the 9th. month 1718. Certified under my hand.
