



By virtue of a Warrant from the Commrs. of Property bearing date the 17th. of the 5th. month, 1716. Surveyed & laid out a certaine piece of Land in the townstead of Newtown in the County of Bucks begining at a Post at John ffrost's Corner from thence by a Road running by the town Lott's South by West. one hundred forty one perches to a Post. Then by vacant Land West by North twenty two perches to another Post. Then by another Road North fourteen degrs. East one hundred & forty seven perches to a Post at John ffrost's other Corner. Then by the sd. John ffrost's Line South sixty three degrs. East twenty two perches & an half to the place of begining. Containing Nineteen Acres & fifty six perches. Surveyed the 27th. day of the 5th. month, 1716.
