



At the Request of Roger Moon and John Burgess Resurveyed and Divided a tract of Land in falls township formerly belonging to James Hill. The sd. Roger Moon's part beginning at a Maple tree in Samuel Dark's Line. From then running by the sd. Line West North West one hundred & ten perches to a black oak, Then by the sd. Dark's Land. West three hundred & ninety perches to a Poplar tree, Then by Joseph Kirkbride's Land. South forty perches to a Post. Then by the sd. John Burgess Line. East three hundred & ninety perches to a Post in a Meadow. Then by the sd. Burgess Line. East South East one hundred & six perches to a Post. Then north North East by the sd. Burgess Land forty perches to the place of beginning. Containing one hundred twenty five acres, Resurveyed as aforesd. the 3^d day of the 4th month Anno Domini, 1715.
