At ye request of John Moore, purchaser of one thousand acres yt I would grant him to take up his proportion of land wth in ye liberties of ye City. These are to will & require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be surveyd unto him twenty acres of land wth in ye bounds thereof where not already taken up according to ye method of townships appointed by me and make returns thereof into my Secretarys office. Given at Philadelphia ye 28th 4th mo. 1683.
