

In pursuance of the Commissioners warrant dated the 12th of the first month 1712₃ I have surveyd unto John Marlow in right of Gilbert Mace his purchase of five hundred acres a lot of land in the city Philad^a bounded northward with the lots of Sassafras street eastward with the sixth ~~sixth~~ street from Delaware southward with Mulberry street and ^{ye} on ^{the} west with a vacant lot being in breadth ~~ninety~~ ninety nine foot and in length three hundred and six foot surveyd & returned into the Secretary's office July the 12th 1718.
