



By ye Commission^{rs} impowerd to grant land & lotts in ye Province of Pennsilvania & ye Territories thereunto belonging

At ye request of Thomas Rutter, in right of Randle Mayling purchaser of two hundred & fifty acres yt we would grant him to take up his lott in ye City proportionable.

These are to will and require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be surveyd unto him a lott on Skulkill in any of ye streets sett out for purchasers of the like quantity he fencing it in & building upon ye same wth in six month from ye date of survey & make returns thereof into ye Secretarys office. Given at Philadelphia ye 12th 7th mo. 1684
