



William Penn Proprietary & Govern<sup>r</sup> of ye Province of Pennsylvania & ye Territories thereunto belonging.

At ye request of George Marys yt I would grant him to take up his proportion of land within ye liberties of ye City joining to Francis Fincher as near as may be.

These are to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyd unto him twenty acres on Skulkill side fifty yards front & in length <sup>as</sup> ye rest & make returns thereof into my Secretary's office.

Given at Philadelphia ye 16<sup>th</sup> 11<sup>th</sup> mo. 1683.
