At ye request of Katharine Martin widdow yt I would grant her to take up a lott in ye city of Philadelphia proportionable to her purchase of five hundred acres.

These are to will and require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be survey'd unto her a lott on Delaware side in ye streets sett out for purchasers of ye like quantity and make returnis thereof into my Secretary's office.

Given at Philadelphia ye 13th 4th mo. 1683.
