



By virtue of a warrant from the Commissioners dated August the twenty eighth one thousand seven hundred and nineteen surveyed and laid out for John Budd and Humphrey Morrey a tract of land situate near Perkiomie in the County of Philadelphia beginning at a black oak being a corner of Samuel Merriam's land thence by Bucks County ^{line} north west four hundred fifty two perches thence by vacant land south west one hundred and thirty perches thence by land of the said Budd south east four hundred fifty ~~two~~ ^{two} perches thence by the said Merriam's land north east one hundred and thirty perches to the place of beginning containing three hundred forty seven acres with allowances of six ~~of~~ cent surveyed Feb. 12th 1723.
