



Resurveyed the above tract of land together with other land in company in Uper bristol township in the County of Philadelphia in ye year 1703, reputed to be the right of Sarah Harsnatt and now at the request of Anth^o Morris Sen^r examined the old lines and renewed the marks whereby he might more perfectly find the bounds of said land.

Begining at a hickry marked ~~as~~ for a corner reputed to be the corner of Whitepaines township from thence by the said townships old line of marked trees north east (the variation considered) four hundred perches to a wt oak thence north west two hundred and ten perches to a post thence south west by an old line of marked trees four hundred and eighty perches to a post in the line of Gilberts Manner from thence by the said line of marked trees south east two hundred and ten perches to a post thence north east eighty perches to the first mentioned hickry containing 630 acres this 4th of ye 5th mo. 1717. *David Powell*
