



By vertue of a warr<sup>t</sup> from ye Court of Upland beareing date November ye 25<sup>th</sup> 1679. laid out for William Orin a tract of land called Edgerly point scituate and being on the west side of Delaware River and on the east side of the Schuylkill. Begining at a corner marked hickery standing by said Creek & from thence North E. b. E. by a line of marked trees obl. perches to corner marked white oake standing neare to an Indian patch or road obliterated of marked trees 50 perches to a corner marked black oak and from thence S. W. b. S. by a line of marked trees 320 perches to a corner marked ~~black~~ oak standing by the side of Schuylkill from thence down by said Creek on severall courses 50 perche<sup>s</sup> to the first mentioned hickery containeing 100<sup>a</sup> land, surveyd the 9<sup>th</sup> 2<sup>d</sup> month 1680.
