



By vertue of a warrant from ye Court of Upland beareing date Novemb.
 28th 1679, layed out for Will^m Orin a tract of land called Edgerle Point
 situated & being on ye west side of Delaware river and on ye East
 side of the Scoolekill, begining at a corner marked hickery stand-
 ing by sd creek and from thence N. E. b. E. by a line of marked
 trees 320 perches to corner marked white oak standing near to an
 Indian patch or road from thence N. W. b. N. by a line of marked
 trees 50 perches to a corner marked black oak and from thence
 S. W. b. S. by a line of marked trees 320 perches to a corner marked
 read oak standing by the side of Scoolekill from thence downe by
 sd creek on severall courses 50 perches to ye first mentioned hickery
 containing 100 acres of land, surveyed the 9th of 2^d mo. 1686.
