By the Commissioners of Property

At the request of Evan Owen that we would grant him to take up four hundred and ninety acres of land in right of a grant of five hundred acres from the proprietor by deeds of lease and release bearing date ye 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> dayes of November 1681 unto George Whitehead who by his deed poll of ye 27 of Septemb<sup>r</sup> 1686 granted all the sd 500 acres unto George Pratt whose heirs Thomas Pratt and Anne Berry with her husband John Berry by their Attorney George Boves all of the County of Talbot in the Province of Maryland by <sup>deeds of</sup> lease and release duly executed by the sd George Boves & bearing date the 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> dayes of this instant conveyed all ye sd 500 acres to the sd Evan Owen his heirs & assigns forever. These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be survey'd to the said Evan Owen according to the method of townships appointed the said quantity of four hundred & ninety acres of land in this Province that has not been already survey'd nor appropriated nor is seated by the Indians and make a return thereof into the Secretaries Office.

Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philad<sup>ia</sup> the 25<sup>th</sup> day of the 11<sup>th</sup> month A.D. 171<sup>5/6</sup>
