being one thousand three hundred & eighty acres in ye County
of Chester. These are in ye Proprietary's name to will &
require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd unto
y^m ye sd number of acres in ye aforementioned County where
not already taken up they seating & improving ye same
with in six months according to regulation & make returns
thereof into ye Secretarys office. Given at Philadelphia
ye 17th 9th mo. 1684
