in ye Province of Pennsilvania & ye territories  
thereunto belonging.

At ye request of William Preston on behalf of John Tizack  
(instead of George Green) purchaser of one thousand acres  
yt we would grant him to take up five hundred acres in  
part in ye County of Chester. These are in ye Proprietary's  
& Govern<sup>rs</sup> name to will & require thee forthwith<sup>th</sup> to survey  
or cause to be survey'd unto him ye sd number of acres  
in ye aforementioned County where not already taken up,  
he seating & improving ye same with<sup>th</sup> six months from ye  
date of survey according to regulation & make returns  
thereof into ye Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia  
ye 26<sup>th</sup> of ye 3<sup>d</sup> mo<sup>o</sup> 1685.
