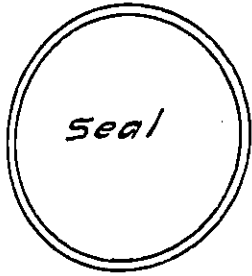

At the request of Owen Thomas Attorney for Henry Saunders that we would grant him ~~to take up~~ a survey on two hundred and fifty acres of land within the bounds of the Welch tract purchased by the said Henry of Jr^o Poyer purchaser of seven hundred and fifty acres. These are to require thee forthwith to survey and lay out to the said Henry Saunders the said quantity of two hundred and fifty acres of land within the bounds of the said Welch tract where not already taken up or seated and make returns thereof into the General Surveyors office at Philadelphia where this warrant is to remain and a copy thereof to be delivered to thee certified by the Secretary who is also to take a duplicate of thy return into his office. Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 16th of the 12th moth 1701.
