Prias ye Jo<sup>s</sup> Hort, The society and ffranc ffincher, upon a hearing of ye matter wee thought ffitt to ord<sup>r</sup> ye caveatts to be taken off.

These are therefore in ye Proprietors name to will and require thee to make returns into ye Secretarys of ye severall tracts of land afore mention for W<sup>ch</sup> this shall be your warr<sup>t</sup> dat at Philadelphia ye 27<sup>th</sup> Apr. 1691.
