At the request of Nathan Thomas of Meirion that we would grant him a resurvey on two hundred and fifty acres of land laid out in Duffein Mawr within the Welch tract (by vertue of a general warrant from the Prop^{rs} for laying out the said tract) to his father James Thomas in right of William Jenkins original purchaser of one thousand acres and by the said James ——— devised to his son the said Nathan ——— by his last will and now in his possession, these are to require thee forthwith to resurvey to the said Nathan Thomas the said two hundred and fifty acres of land situate as aforesaid and make returns thereof into the General Surveyors office at Philadelphia where this warrant is to remain and a copy thereof to be delivered to thee certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 6th day of the 2^d moth 1702.
