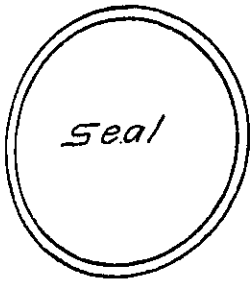

At the request of Nathan Thomas that we would grant him a resurvey on eighty one acres of land laid out in the township of Haverford within the Welch tract by virtue of a general warrant from the Proprietary bearing date the 13th of the first month 1684. seventy five thereof in right of Evan Thomas and four acres in right of William Homel purchasers under Lewis David. These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey to the sd Nathan Thomas the said eighty one acres of land situate as afore-sd and make returns thereof into the General Surveyors office at Philadelphia where this warrant is to remain and a copy thereof to be delvd to thee attested by the Secretary who is also to take a duplicate ~~thereof~~ ^{ye Province} of thy return in to his office. Given under our hands and seal at Philadelphia the 11th of the 12th month 1701.
