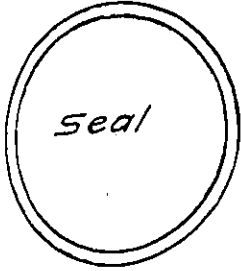


Pennsylvania obl.

By the Commission^{rs} of Property

At the request of Abel Thomas that we would grant him a resurvey on seventy six acres and a half of land on which he is seated within the Welch tract by him purchasobl. of Hugh Roberts to whom the same was laid out together with a larger quantity by vertue of a ^{Genl} warrant from the Prop^{ty} dated in the first month 1684 and in right of John Thomas and Edward Jones purchasers of 5000 acres. These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey to the sd Abel — the sd quantity of seventy six acres and a half where he is now seated and make returns thereof into the General Surveyors office at Philad^{ia} where this warrant is to remain and a copy thereof to be delivd thee certified by the secretary who is also to take a duplicate of thy return into his office. Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 16th of y^e 12th moth 1701.
