



October the 30 1683 surveyed for Robert Taylor 530 acres of land lying on the west side of darby creek beginning at a marked post being the mark of John Knowls land and running along the 5<sup>d</sup> Knowls line of markt trees N.E.b.E. 480 perch to a marked white oak standing by darby creek then up the creek on severall courses to a marked red oak from thence S.W.b.W. 470 perch to a marked post the S.S.E. 20 perch to a marked post from thence S.S.E. ~~100~~ 180 perch to ye first post.
