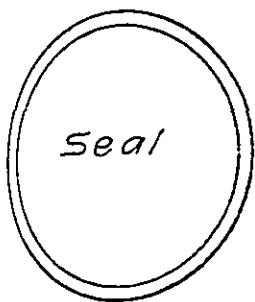

At the request of John David Thomas that we would grant him a resurvey on two hundred and ten acres of land laid out in Duffein Mawr within the Welch tract by vertue of a general warrant from the Proprietary dated the 13<sup>th</sup> of the first month 1684. in right of Rees Rytharch, purchaser under Lewis David. These are to require the forthw<sup>th</sup> to resurvey to the sd John David Thomas the said two hundred and ten acres scituate as aforesaid and in his possession now being, and make returns thereof into ye Surveyors office at Philadelphia where this warrant is to remain and a copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by the Secretary who is also to take a duplicate of thy return into his office. Given under our hands and seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 16<sup>th</sup> of the 12<sup>th</sup> mo<sup>th</sup> 1701.
