two hundred & fifty acres yt we would grant him to take up
ye remaind^r of his purchase being five hundred & thirty acres
in ye County of Chester. These are in ye Proprietary's name
to will & require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be survey'd
unto him ye sd number of acres in ye aforesaid County
where not already taken up after ^{all} former warr^{rs} executed
he seating & improving ye same wth six months from ye
date of survey & make returns thereof into the Secretary's
office. Given at Philadelphia ye 27th of 11th mo. 1681
