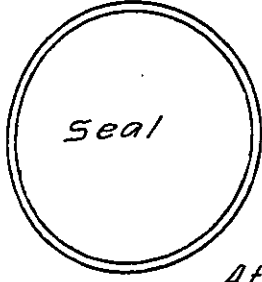


Pennsylvania }
