By the Commissioners of Property.

At the request of Richard Murry of Philadelphia County that we would grant him to take up the quantity of five hundred acres of land the remainder of one thousand acres the original purchase made of the late Proprietor by Thomas Roberts whose brother and heir Nathanael Roberts by deeds of lease & release dated the 18th & 19th days of October Anno—1723, granted and convey'd the same unto the said Richard Murry. These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be survey'd in the aforesaid right according to the method of townships appointed the said quantity of five hundred acres of land that has not been already survey'd nor appropriated nor is seated by the Indians and make returns thereof into the Secretary's office in order for a further confirmation. Given under our hands and the lesser seal of the Province at Philadelp^a the tenth day of December Anno Dni 1726.
