Minshall, William Taylor, peter Taylor, Randle Croxton and Thomas Powell each of them three hundred acres a pise only Randle Croxton is 2 hundred 45 acres & next unto them Allen Robbinet & Randle — makin each of them 2 hundred 45 acres a pise and next unto John Edge, Joseph Powell & Joseph Stidman one hundred and twenty acres a pise and let all thise be survaied in orded after one another as the are mentiend hirein and to returne to mee a true duplicate of the filed work and protracted figue which is to remaine in my office dated this 9th 7^{mo} 1682
